**Beneficiary Narrative**  
 Jane Doe is a 9 year old female with cystic fibrosis. She lives at home with her mother. She has significant, chronic, and complex medical conditions that require the intervention, monitoring, and support of a nurse. ANC will support Jane in managing breathing through use of a PT chest vest and suctioning.

**Plan Narrative**  
 To meet Jane Doe's medical needs, ANC will be coordinated for her with supplemental PDN services through Nursing Professionals, Inc. An EOR has been identified and trained. That person is Feb Doe. A nurse has been identified and has passed the background check and competency evaluation. The nurse is Mar Doe who is her mother. Her nurse license number is 5555555. The mother is a RN and does not require supervision. An LPN, Janice Deer, has been hired and has passed the background check and competency evaluation. Her nurse license number is 5545544. She will be supervised by Mar Doe who is an RN. A total of 25 hours/week are approved. These hours were previously approved through PDN and will be partially covered by ANC (20hr per week covered by PDN, 5hr per week covered by ANC). PDN hours of coverage will be Monday-Thursday, 5 hours per day from 12N- 5pm. ANC hours of coverage will be Fridays, 5 hours per day from 12N-5pm. Respite services are covered by both the nursing agency and Janice Deer. Nursing Angles, Inc. will provide 2,000 units. Janice Deer will provide 880 units. The PDN provider has been notified of the transition to ANC consumer-directed and is in agreement that ANC will cover the above listed hours.

#### Beneficiary Narrative

Jane Doe is a 9 year old female with cystic fibrosis. She lives at home with her mother. She has significant, chronic, and complex medical conditions that require the intervention, monitoring, and support of a nurse.

#### Plan Narrative

Jane is approved for 25 hours of PDN services per week; however, 5 of those hours are unstaffed. The core reason for the uncovered hours is her location in Rocky Mount NC where there is a shortage of available nurses. Efforts to solicit a nurse have included contacting 4 local PDN agencies: Angelic Care Nursing, Inc, Staffing Professionals, Nurses Care, and Healthcare Providerz, none of which have nurses available during Jane's hours of need.

PNA services are requested during the documented uncovered 5 hours. Her current PDN agency Nursing Professionals, Inc is willing to provide an aide to help the PCG with aide tasks.

During the time PNA provides services the primary caregiver is available to perform the nurse level care. A total of 25 nursing hours/week are approved. These hours were previously approved through PDN. The hours of coverage will be: PDN 20 hours scheduled Mondays-Thursdays 8:00am-10:30a and 2:30pm-5:00pm. PNA 5 hours Scheduled Fridays 8:00am-10:30am and 2:30pm-5:00pm.
