

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs) PCS Provider Webinar June 26, 2025

- Q. Could you clarify the number of hours one can receive for Personal Care Services (PCS)?
 - **A.** NC Medicaid beneficiaries who are 18 and older may receive up to 80 PCS hours per month and may qualify for additional hours with Session Law 2013-306 if they meet certain criteria. Beneficiaries under the age of 18 may get up to 60 PCS hours per month.
- **Q.** How long does it generally take to receive a response if someone already has a Referral Screening Verification Process (RSVP) number?
 - **A.** If you communicate by email to obtain a prior RSVP number, a response will be provided within three business days or less.
- Q. What type of license is required to provide Transitions to Community Living (TCL)?
 - **A.** No license is required to perform TCL. TCL is a settlement agreement between NCD_and USDOJ.
